Dear Arts, Crafts and Food Vendors,

Leaders and volunteers in Marine City have come together to organize a music and arts festival scheduled for July 9, 10, 11 and 12 of 2009. Marine City Music Festival Inc. was established to be the parent organization responsible for running the festival. This celebration of music and the arts will open with a beach party on Thursday night, July 9. Reggae music and a "Taste Fest" put on by local restaurants will establish a festive atmosphere. Adult beverages will be sold in a large tent at waterside. Friday the music continues with local musical groups performing in the parks on Water St. from noon to night. Come evening an all Celtic program with pipe band, Irish orchestra and Scottish dancers will be presented. Saturday will feature a "battle of the bands" from noon to late afternoon. Come evening the music will be a series of Blues bands performing in the tent. Sunday morning will feature a Gospel group and a student recital in a local church. In the afternoon country/western and folk music in the waterside park and a string quartet will conclude the evening.

Fine Arts exhibits are also planned. A Quilt Show of over 100 quilts will be housed in the activities rooms of Holy Cross Church. A photography, painting and ceramics exhibit will be housed in a vacant store front on Water St. A kids "Sidewalk Art" project will continue all weekend. A "Maritime Artifacts" exhibit that illustrates Marine City ship building history is planned but the location is still to be determined.

We invite you to participate. Vendors will be assigned 10' X 10' spaces in the waterside parks close to the performance areas and pedestrian routes. The festival will be well advertised with stories and ads in Detroit and Port Huron daily papers and the regional weekly paper. Advertising will also be done in Canada through Chambers of Commerce and newspaper ads. Local cable TV will carry announcements and schedules. Signage will be erected in advance at all major entry points to the city. Security patrols will be provided to keep vendors' booths safe.
